<b>Airport Transfers</b>	<p>Both pick-ups and drop-offs are available only at Suvarnabhumi International Airport.</p> <p><u>Pick-up</u>  Pick-up date: <b>26 July 2026</b>      Pick-up time: <b>1:00 p.m.</b>  Location: Near Exit 1, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Suvarnabhumi International Airport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants must book flights to arrive at Suvarnabhumi International Airport before 1:00 p.m.</li> <li>• If your flight arrives at Don Muang Airport, please arrange to transfer to Suvarnabhumi International Airport before the pick-up time.</li> <li>• The pick-up bus for Naresuan University will depart from Suvarnabhumi International Airport at 1:00 p.m.</li> <li>• To ensure a smooth arrival and avoid any potential delays, we kindly recommend that participants consider booking flights to arrive earlier than the deadline.</li> </ul> <p><u>Drop-off</u>  Drop-off date: <b>8 August 2026</b>  Departure time from NU dormitory: 6:00 a.m.  Location: The 4th floor of Suvarnabhumi Airport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Participants should book a return flight after 3:00 p.m.</li> <li>• Please bear in mind that it takes around 6-7 hours from Naresuan University to Suvarnabhumi International Airport.</li> <li>• If participants go to other places which is not Suvarnabhumi International Airport on 8 August 2026, they must be responsible for the arrangements themselves.</li> </ul>
<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>13 nights of accommodation will be arranged for all participants at on-campus dormitory (NU Dorm). Each room is arranged on a twin-sharing basis. NU Dorm provides fully furnished accommodation to its occupants, replete with amenities such as AC, electric fans, desks, ironing, bathroom facilities, water heaters, and clotheslines.</p> <p>Any participants, who arrive before our program commences or after the program schedules, will be required to make their own accommodation arrangements.</p>
<b>Performances</b>	<p>The participants are required to present and perform your own culture for the two activities as follows;</p> <p><b>1) Thursday, 6 August 2026 “Internationalization at Home”</b></p> <p>This activity is an intercultural performance by exchange students to present your own culture or country to Naresuan University’s students (about 80 – 100 students). For the performance, it can be a cultural performance, PowerPoint or video presentation of your country, dance, quiz games, folk games, traditional games with small gifts (candy or snack from your country), children’s games, traditional toys, origami (paper cutting), calligraphy, or other fun activities. You can do it personally or you can do it in a group with the same nationality.</p>

	<p><b>2) Friday, 7 August 2026 “Farewell Party”</b></p> <p>All participants are required to perform one easy performance, which can be dancing, singing (in your own language), traditional dancing, talent show, and etc. Also, you can do it personally or you can do it in a group with the same university.</p>
