Important Notes for Application

- The application will be completed only after all required information has been entered and the application fee has been paid by the application deadline.
 - Applicants must carefully check their eligibility and the department to which they are applying before submitting the application. **The application fee is non-refundable after the application deadline.**
 - **The applied department may be changed only during the application period.**
 - In the case of multiple applications within the same application round, applications other than the initial application will be canceled.
 - **Applicants must enter all information accurately, including email address and phone number.**
 - An application number will be issued after submission and will be used for information regarding the interview schedule, admission results.
 - **Even if you have completed the online application, if you do not submit the required documents until submission period, you will not be able to take the interview and will be disqualified.**
 - Applicants should submit completed paperwork during application period, if applicants fail to submit the required documents which affects admission status, he/she will be disqualified without further notice.
 - Only language proficiency test scores issued within the past two (2) years will be accepted.
(TOPIK, TOEFL, IELTS, TEPS, and New TEPS; JLPT excluded)
 - If applicants submit the scanned copies of documents, they must submit original documents later. If these two documents are not the same, your admission cannot be guaranteed.
 - All the submitted documents except the original diploma, graduation certificate will not be returned.
 - Applicants who submitted a certificate of expected graduation at the time of application must submit the original degree certificate or graduation certificate to the Office of International Affairs by **February 19, 2027**. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.
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Reminders

- **Admitted students who are expected to graduate must obtain the required degree before the start of the semester; otherwise the admission will be cancelled.**
 - If any of the applicant's documents contain false information, omissions, or forgery, or if the applicant is found to have gained admission through improper means, such as a proxy interview, or if the applicant's degree is not recognized by JBNU, the admission will be cancelled even if the applicant is already attending the university and the tuition fee will be not refunded. Furthermore they cannot apply for Jeonbuk National University for next 3 years
 - **JBNU is not responsible for admission cancellation due to the mistakes made on the application, missing documents, and unfulfilled entry procedures.**
 - All the information including admission results announcements will be posted on the homepage. Please follow the directions carefully.
 - **Evaluation scores for admission will not be announced.**
 - All accepted applicants must complete all admission and registration procedures before the deadline. If the tuition fee has not been paid on the given deadline, the admission will be cancelled.
 - Among those who are admitted, students whose Korean proficiency is found to be less than adequate to effectively participate in class might be required to take a Korean Language class.
 - The applicants who applied for the department which is different from the major of his/her graduating school **must take additional pre-requisites** except graduation credits. Doctorate program applicants who have graduated from a special graduate school must also take additional pre-requisites except graduation credits.
 - Regulations of Jeonbuk National University are applied to the items that are not defined on this prospectus and other particulars are decided by the Graduate School Committee.
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※ This admission guideline is originally written in Korean and translated into English and Chinese.
In case of any discrepancies, the Korean version shall prevail over the translated versions.

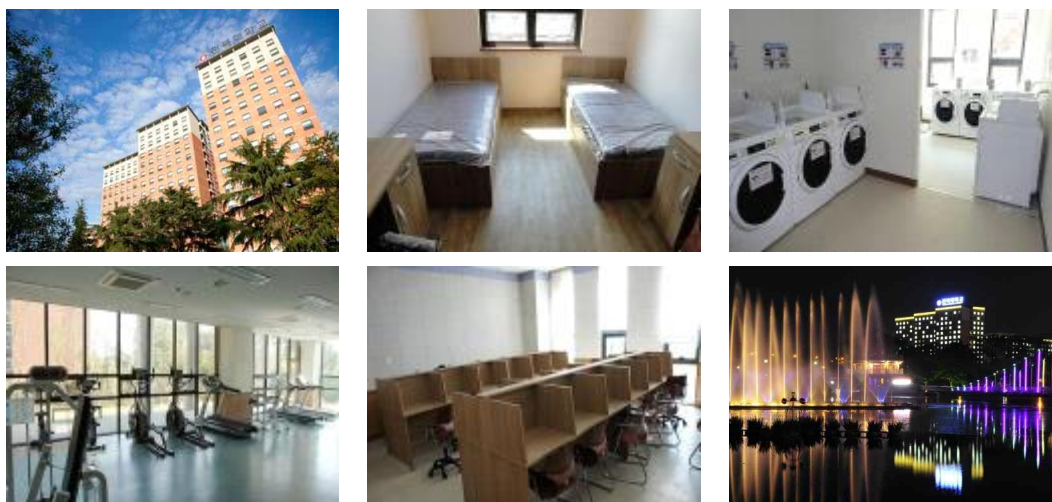

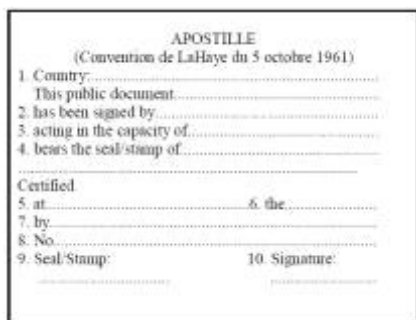

The Convention provides for the simplified certification or public (including notarized) documents to be used in countries that have joined the convention.

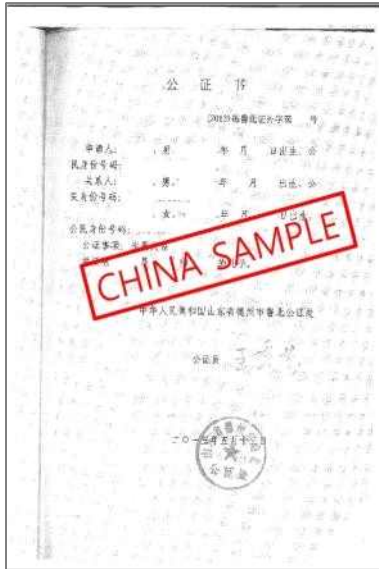
■ Students admitted from countries which are NOT signatories to the convention and do not recognize the Apostille must meet the following requirements:

- Applicants from these countries should submit their official certificates with an authentication attachment (e.g., Certificate of Authentication or Certificate of Overseas Educational Institutions) issued by the Korean Embassy or Consulate.
- Those who get a diploma from Universities in China should submit the degree certificate from the CHSI (www.chsi.com.cn)

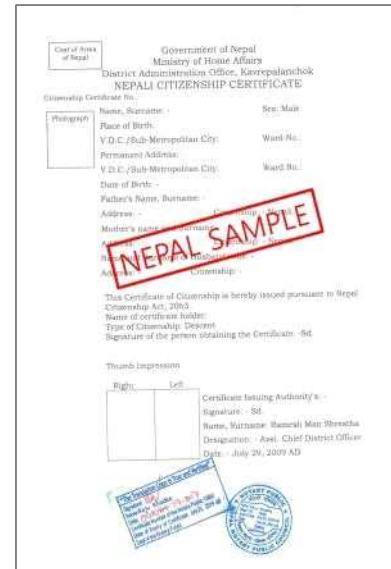

Improvement of recognition standards for international students' academic background requirements (Ministry of Justice notification)

(D-2, D-4-1.7) As there are many cases in countries where it is difficult to submit documents proving academic qualifications, such as a graduation certificate, when applying, the standards for proving academic qualifications have been improved by taking into account the current situation of each country.

China follows current 『Guidelines for Visa Issuance and Residence Management for Foreign Students』

Expansion of the scope of recognition of high school graduation certificates ► Countries that require a national exam for university admission recognize the test certificate as a document proving academic qualification requirements.

※ However, you must obtain an Apostille from the country issuing the document or consular confirmation from the Korean embassy in the country where you reside.

◎ Documents proving academic requirements equivalent to high school graduation by country ◎

(India) Migration Certificate (issued by central and local educational evaluations such as CBSE, ICSE, IB)

(Nepal) Academic Transcript

- Issuer ① Before 2016 (2073 in Nepalese calendar): HSEB (Higher Secondary Education Board)

② After 2016 (Nepal calendar year 2073): NEB (National Examination Board)

(Myanmar) Matriculation Examination Pass Certificate

※ All 6 subjects must score 40 points or higher.

(Malaysia) Academic performance evaluation transcript (SPM: Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia or STPM: Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia)

※ In case of SPM certificate, submit it together with the School Leaving Certificate.

(Other countries) If tests or qualifications equivalent to the qualifications for university admission are stipulated by national law or official document, it can be recognized as a document proving the academic background requirements.

※ However, the applicant must explain the qualification criteria according to the laws or official documents of the relevant country.

Exceptional recognition for certificate of expected graduation

(Eligible countries) Countries where official graduation certificates are typically issued several months after graduation

*Vietnam, Myanmar, Nepal, India, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, Cambodia, Israel, and other countries where the delayed issuance of high school, university, or graduate school graduation certificates can be verified through official government documents

(Eligible Applicants) Applicants whose graduation date is within one year from the date of issuance of the Certificate of Admission

(Accepted Documents) Certificate of expected graduation or temporary graduation certificate, etc.

* Various names such as Provisional Certificate or Temporary Certificate are recognized, but must receive Apostille from the issuing country or consular confirmation from the Korean embassy in the country where the document is issued.
